


Activity: Which number is more?


Each box has two sets of items. Count them aloud and write the numbers in the circle below them.

Draw a line under the number which is more.

Below each group is a large empty circle for writing the count. A dashed line is drawn below the circle under the second group.




The first group contains 25 peaches arranged in 5 rows of 5. The second group contains 20 peaches arranged in 5 rows of 4.
